## Local Casino Collectibles Club Memorabilia Show Next Weekend

*Southern Nevada Casino Collectibles Club hosts first casino mementos show September 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> at the Gold Coast Casino*

LAS VEGAS (September 16, 2022) — If you remember old Vegas fondly, the [Southern Nevada Casino Collectibles Club](#)'s (SNCCC) casino souvenirs show is right up your glitter gulch. Yesteryear is on display at the local casino memorabilia club's first-ever casino collectibles show, and everyone is invited to come and enjoy the many artifacts of Las Vegas as it was. The show runs 9 am to 5 pm Friday and Saturday September 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> at the Gold Coast Casino, California Ballrooms L & K.

Over thirty dealers, many of them local, will be on hand displaying collections of all sorts of icons of Las Vegas'



past, including casino chips, tokens, dice, playing cards, slot cards and slot glass, room keys, advertising items – all kinds of casino souvenirs – both common and rare. Add to your collection or bring your collections to the show for an on-site expert evaluation.





Las Vegas resident Tom McEvoy, the 1983 winner of the World Series of Poker Main Event will be on hand. The Poker Hall of Famer has had a fascinating poker career, with many stories about his experiences with some of the most fabled names in poker history. If you'd like to know more about the early days of the World Series of Poker, and chat with him in person.

Also on display will be the current Guinness World Record of the largest private personal collection of casino chips and gaming tokens from different casinos - 2,222 items - achieved by Las Vegas resident and SNCCC member Gregg Fisher.



“Show visitors will see so many examples of what Vegas used to be like when comps were king, and casinos branded everything in sight. They wanted their customers to take home these special items as valued reminders of the great time they had. Now so many are hard to find. The SNCCC is a club with over 200 members who love to collect casino souvenirs, and also love to share these artifacts and the stories behind them.
