At the February 14, 2023 meeting, the feature speaker will be Paul Papa. He is a full-time writer and ghostwriter of both fiction and nonfiction who has lived in Las Vegas for more than thirty years. His fifteen years working for casinos inspired his book, Maximum Rossi, which garnered him the prestigious Next Generation Indie Book Award, and Desert Dust, which won him the Will Rogers Medallion Award. In his role as a security officer, Paul was the person who actually shut and locked the doors of the Sands Hotel and Casino for the final time. He eventually became a hotel investigator for a major Strip casino, during which time he developed a love for writing stories about uncommon events. His presentation will be on our Facebook live broadcast.

SNCCC Fall Show Dealer Information

Sound System, Tables, Signage, Linen

Greetings to all prospective dealers for our second annual 2023 Fall Show. While still in the planning stages, starting with a larger room this year, it will be on the opposite end of the casino where the Valet is located. Here are some items that you should know to make this a very enjoyable experience.

Show Hours. Show hours have changed from last year.

- Dealer Setup will be on Thursday Sept 21 from 12 noon to 5 pm, Friday Sept 22 from 7am to 9 am and Saturday Sept 23 from 7 am to 9 am. Dealers will have access to the freight elevator, escalator and through the Valet entrance. We will be in Salon F in the Arizona Ball room section of the Casino.
- Show hours are from 9 am to 4 pm on Friday Sept 22 and 9 am to 3 pm on Saturday Sept 23.

Tablecloths. We have enough tablecloths to cover all the tables during the show. Please remember that the tablecloths are the property of the SNCCC and must be left at the show. We want to keep costs down to minimize our expenses for future shows. At the end of the Show please fold your tablecloths and place them on top of your tables. We will pick them up and get them ready for cleaning. We do *not* have enough tablecloths to cover dealer tables overnight, so please bring some type of material to cover your table if you wish.

Two wheelers and carts. The casino does not have any carts or two wheelers that we can use. We will have a two-wheeler and two mini-wheelers for use if needed. you need one. If you are checking in at the Valet you can request a bellman to place your items on their large cart and bring them to the showroom.

Taxes. Terri Lonski (Club Treasurer) will be passing out your Tax declaration form at set up time. Your name has been given to the Tax authorities and it is your responsibility to make sure that Terri receives the completed form a couple of hours before the show ends. She is the only person authorized to receive the envelope. You can enclose cash as well as a check. We will convert your cash to a check form when it is sent out afterwards.

Goody Bags. If you wish to have some promotional material, coupons, or ads placed in the goody bags, please bring your items on Thursday, Set Up day. Volunteers will be stuffing bags for Show attendees on Thursday.

Point of Contact. Jerry Vergatos is the Show Chairman, and will be the point of contact for the show. He plans on being on the show floor from open to close, headquartered most of the time at the Registration Desk. If you cannot find him, any of the SNCCC Board members will be able to assist you. They are:

Theft. Generally speaking, we would not recommend you accept chips for payment rather than cash or credit card if you have that service.

Security. The room will be locked up at 5pm at the end of each day. Although some like to socialize after the show is over in the showroom, we would ask that you do so at one of the other locations in the Casino. Show staff will have to stay till everyone leaves and security wants the room cleared. We also recommend that you do not leave any high value items in the room. Our insurance only covers liability.

Badges. All Dealers and Helpers must pick up a badge at the Registration Table. All badges must be picked up in person *only* by the person named. Please wear your badges during the show so we know who is authorized to come and go.

Tear Down. To avoid confusion please do not try to leave early as we only have one set of doors to enter and exit. Leaving early may cause a bottle neck and confusion. You can certainly pack your table, but we ask that you exit when the show is over at 3pm. Keep in mind there may still be attendees in the room.

Room Reservations. We have contracted a room package for the Show. Our Room Block code is NCCI23P (Please note the 4th character is the letter I not the number 1) The resort fee has not been discounted this year, but the rates have been lowered more to compensate for the increase.

Early Bird Deposit. We will be accepting a nonrefundable deposit of \$50 for any location on the showroom floor you may want. This is on a first come first call basis. Please visit our website at snccc.club to see the show floor layout, then pick your desired spot and email Jerry. He will let you know if it's available. If available, your deposit or full payment will be needed within 4 days.


