

SNCCC Fall Show Dealer Information

1/10/2023

Greetings to all prospective dealers for our 2023 Fall Show. We have contracted for a larger room this year. While still in the planning stages we hope to make this show bigger and better than any show you have experienced. Listed here are some items that you should know to make this a very enjoyable experience.

Show Hours Our show hours have changed from last year. **Dealer Setup** will be on Thursday Sept 21 from 12 noon to 5 pm Friday Sept 22 from 7am to 9 am and Saturday from 7 am to 9 am. **Show hours** are from 9 am to 4 pm on Friday and 9 am to 3 pm on Saturday

Showroom. We have contracted for a larger space on the end of the casino where the Valet is located. You will have access with the freight elevator, escalator and through the Valet entrance. We will be in Salon F in the Arizona Ball room section of the Casino.(see attached map)

Tablecloths Please remember that the tablecloths are the property of the SNCCC and must be left at the show. We want to keep costs down to minimize our expenses for future shows. **At the end of the Show please fold your tablecloths** and place them on top of your tables. We will pick them up and get them ready for cleaning. We have had a difficult time ordering enough tablecloths to cover your tables **overnight** so please bring some type of material to **cover your table if you wish** . We have enough tablecloths to supply all the dealers during the show (bottoms)

Two wheelers and carts The casino does not have any carts or two wheelers that we can use. I will have a two-wheeler for use if you need one. I will also have 2 mini wheelers as well. If you are checking in at the Valet you can request a bellman to place your items on their large cart and bring them to the showroom.

Taxes Terri Lonski (Club Treasurer) will be passing out your Tax declaration form at set up time. Your name will have been given to the Tax authorities and it is your responsibility to make sure that Terri receives the form (completely filled out) a couple of hours before the show ends. She is the only person authorized to receive the envelope. You can enclose cash as well as a check. We will convert your cash to a check form when it is sent out afterwards.

Goody Bags If you wish to have some promotional material ,coupon, or Ads placed in the goody bags please bring your items on Set up day. There are volunteers that will be stuffing bags for Show attendees on Thursday

Point of Contact Jerry will be the point of contact for the show. I plan on being on the Show floor from open to close. I will be headquartered most of the time at the Registration Desk. If there is a reason I am not available any of the SNCCC BoD members will be able to assist you. They are:

Theft Generally speaking, we would not recommend you accept chips for payment other than Cash or Credit Card if you have that service .

Security The room will be locked up at 5pm at the end of each day. Although some like to socialize after the show is over in the showroom I would ask that you do so at one of the other locations in the Casino. I will have to stay till everyone leaves and security wants the room cleared. I would also recommend that you do not leave any high value items in the room. Our insurance only covers liability.

Badges All Dealers and Helpers will have a badge for picking up at the registration Table. **Please do not attempt to pick up your helper's/co Dealers badges as they need to do so themselves.** Please wear your badges during the show so we know who is authorized to come and go.

Tear Down To avoid much confusion please do not try to leave early as we only have one set of doors to enter and exit. Leaving early may cause a bottle neck and confusion. You can certainly pack your table, but we ask that you exit when the show is over at 5pm. Keep in mind there may still be attendees in the room. We are heavily advertising the show on the radio for the locals.

Room Reservations We have contracted a room package for the Show. Our Room Block code is NCCI23P (Please note the 4th character is the letter I not the number 1) The resort fee has not been discounted this year, but the rates have been lowered more to compensate for the increase. (See attached sheet)

Early Bird Deposit We will be accepting a nonrefundable deposit of \$50 for any location on the showroom floor you may want. This is on a first come first call basis. Attached is the floor layout. You must email me your desired spot and I will let you know if it's available. If so I will need your deposit or full payment within 4 days.

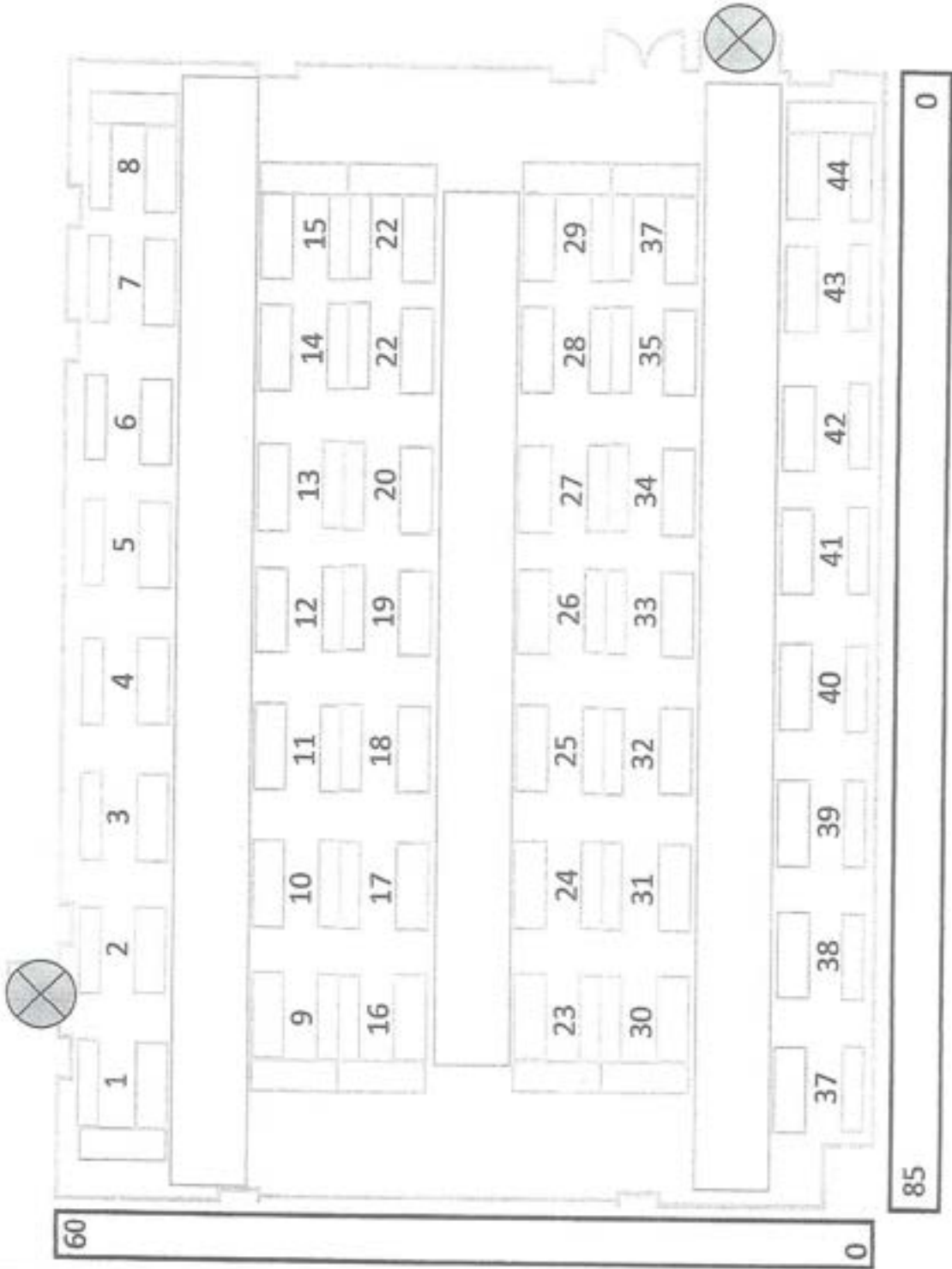

The doors open as early as 6PM and trading, buying and selling of casino collectibles go on before, during and after the meeting. We usually have a guest speaker, a raffle and an auction. Guests are always welcome free of charge.



Casino collectibles have been around as long as casinos have but it wasn't until the 1980's that collectors began talking with each other on a regular basis and dealers developed that concentrated on casino material.

Before the 1980's, chips and tokens could be found outside of casinos only as oddities: a few chips or tokens mixed in with a coin dealer's stock, or a few chips at an antiques shop or garage sale.



The hobby has expanded exponentially into literally every aspect of gaming in America and in fact across the entire world. No item is too small or too large to be a "collectible" if it has an identifiable logo or casino name on it!



Items that have become collectible include poker chips; casino chips, antique gaming chips, dice, match books, ashtrays, postcards, napkins, coasters, menus, plaques and silver strikes. Nothing is out of bounds and people do, in fact, collect things that the average person would simply say, "YOU ARE KIDDING!" Table layouts for roulette, blackjack and craps, actual signs from the casinos, the glass fronts to slot machines, and of course the slot machines themselves are also highly collectible.

It was a pleasure speaking with you in regards to hosting Southern Nevada Casino Collectibles Club. Thank you for bringing this opportunity to Gold Coast Hotel & Casino. The following contract outlines your requirements.

This contract (hereinafter referred to as "**Agreement**") is between Southern Nevada Casino Collectibles Club (hereinafter referred to as "**Group**") and Gold Coast Hotel & Casino (hereinafter referred to as "**Hotel**") for Southern Nevada Casino Collectibles Club (hereinafter referred to as "**Event**") on 9/20/23 - 9/26/23.

A group must consist of a minimum of ten (10) rooms to receive group rates. Any group falling below the ten (10) room requirement must pay prevailing hotel room rate.

GUEST ROOM AND RATE COMMITMENT

The **Hotel** is pleased to offer **Group** the following room and group rate commitment:

Rooms are blocked run-of-house, based on hotel availability. All rooms have either one king bed OR two queen beds; only non-smoking rooms are available. Inventories of specific room types are limited. We will make every attempt to accommodate requests for specific room types but cannot guarantee availability. Single or double occupancy is considered the same regarding rooms blocked and room rates. Saturday arrivals and departures may not be available unless contracted in this **Agreement**.

Please be advised that all rates quoted are net, per room, per night, allowing for single or double occupancy. Any Deluxe rooms requiring triple occupancy will be surcharged an additional \$20.00 per room, per night plus tax. (Children age fifteen and under, in the same room with parents in existing bedding, are free.) All rates are subject to a Clark County room tax, currently 13.38%. This tax is subject to increase without prior notice.

Currently, this block of rooms is being held on an option basis until 11/11/22. Upon receipt of an executed original of this **Agreement**, the block will be confirmed as definite. The **Hotel** reserves the right to release all requested space for general sales on the decision date.

RESORT FEE

Hotel has a mandatory \$30.99 plus tax, per room, per day, Resort Fee which is in addition to room and tax charges. Benefits include in-room Wi-Fi, access to the Fitness Center, in-room coffee, in-room safe, unlimited local & 800 calls as well as free Wi-Fi in Java Vegas Coffee Shop & High-Speed Internet Access in our Business Center. The Resort Fee and its inclusions are subject to increase without prior notice.

BELLMAN SERVICES

It is presumed that each arrival of **Group's** contingency will be on a separate and individual basis. **Group** baggage handling is available on request and will be subject to a \$4.50 per person, round-trip, bellman gratuity to allow for in-house baggage handling. The gratuity is subject to increase without notice. All motor coach groups are preregistered and pre-keyed.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Check-in for group arrivals begins at 4:00 p.m. Check-out time is at 12:00 noon. **Hotel** agrees to make rooms available prior to the stated check-in time and to extend late check-out to guests on a preferential basis, if available. An early check-in fee will apply, early check in is from 7:00am – 1:00pm.

GENERAL HOTEL POLICIES

Guestrooms must be occupied and registered to at least one adult, who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older. **PHOTO IDENTIFICATION WILL BE REQUIRED UPON CHECK-IN.** **Hotel** reserves the right to refuse or terminate service to any individual(s) when not in compliance with this policy.

Group reservations cannot be accepted until **Hotel receives an original executed **Agreement** and the space has been converted to a definite basis.**

At check-in, all guests will be required to post a valid credit card to secure their individual room accounts and to cover an additional \$100.00 security/damage deposit for standard guest rooms; \$250.00 for a one-bedroom King Executive Suite and two-bedroom Executive Suite; and \$500.00 for a one-bedroom Luxury Suite or two-bedroom Presidential Suite.

PACKAGES/FREIGHT

Instructions for **Inbound Freight** for a meeting or convention are noted under Catering Standard Terms & Conditions in this **Agreement**.

Boxes/envelopes sent to an **individual** guest will be held at the bell desk and cannot be delivered to the convention floor; the guest will be required to pick up and sign for the delivery or have the bell desk deliver the shipment to their guest room.

Deliveries (made by **Hotel's** Bell staff) to guest rooms are \$20.00 per cart each way. Charges are determined by size and quantity of items.

Should any member of **Group** wish to have gift bags or handouts given to **Group's** attendees the Bell staff service charge will be of \$5.00 to \$10.00 per item.

Additional fees may apply for excess weight or size.

RESERVATION PROCEDURES

Reservations will be made in **Passkey** by weblink or telephone. **Hotel** will upload these reservations to hotel reservation system through the **Passkey** portal on the scheduled cut-off date.
